

Application Instructions

- Please print legibly or type. Return the application with a \$200 housing application and contract fee to the Office of University Housing. Make checks payable to: Lawrence Technological University.
- It is important that the student completes the application, not the parent or guardian.
- Lawrence Tech reserves the right to assign or deny housing at its sole discretion.
- Please visit ltu.edu/housing for current rates and requirements.

1. Lifestyle choices

- To help University Housing choose a roommate on your behalf, answer the questions honestly, as they apply to you currently.

2. Definitions

- Neat: orderly in appearance and organization.
- Lived in: comfortable – neither neat nor messy.
- Messy: untidy, disorderly in appearance and organization.
- Morning person: one who rises early to accomplish goals and activities; goes to bed in the evening.
- Afternoon/evening person: one who begins their day in the early afternoon; goes to bed late at night.
- Late night person: one who does not begin their day until the late night; goes to bed in the early morning.

3. Room preferences

- Please rank, from 1 – 7, your room preference in desired order.
 - 1 means most desired
 - 7 means least desired
- Unless stated “single,” all rooms are double occupancy (two students per bedroom).
- Single rooms are single occupancy (one student per bedroom).
- Single spaces/rooms are limited.
- Every effort is made to accommodate your preferences. If your preferences cannot be met, you will be placed according to availability.

4. Students with disabilities

- If you have a disability and require accommodations for housing, please contact the Office of University Housing and request the *Housing Accommodations Request* form.

5. Roommate preference

- If you know of a student with whom you would like to share a room with, write their name in the allotted space. The request must be mutual; the student must want to live with you as well.
- University Housing will not honor any roommate request that may discriminate against another student.

6. Smoke-free housing

- All residence halls are smoke free.
- If you do smoke, you will be matched up with other students who smoke.

Contract Terms and Conditions

Highlights

1. A \$200 housing application and contract fee is required.
2. Cancellation dates and fees are in effect regardless of when you apply.
3. Application is for the summer session only.
4. There is no trial period or temporary housing available.
5. The contract is not a lease and cannot be terminated at will.
6. You may request to cancel the contract; however, the request is not a guarantee. If the request is approved, you will be billed a forfeiture fee.
7. When you sign the application and contract, you acknowledge that:
 - You have read and understood the entire application and contract.
 - You agree to the entire application and contract.
 - Do not sign if you do not understand or agree with any of the statements on the application and contract.

Housing Contract

Terms and Conditions

The undersigned student wishes to reside in a Lawrence Technological University residence hall and agrees to pay the housing application and contract fee in the amount of \$200 (must be paid prior to contract period). Payment will be kept on file and does not need to be paid again as long as the student continues to reside in University Housing. Payment will be released back to the student's account after he or she permanently moves out of University Housing.

Please initial the following two paragraphs:

_____ If the student notifies the Office of University Housing in writing by May 1 of his or her desire to cancel the application and contract, no penalty will be assessed. If the student notifies the Office of University Housing after May 1, the student will be charged a \$200 housing forfeiture fee. If the student fails to occupy the assigned room after registering for classes at the University, he or she may be liable for the cost of that room for the summer session.

_____ This contract covers housing for the entire summer session through the first day of classes for the fall semester. If the student wishes to terminate the contract, an application to terminate must be submitted to the Office of University Housing. If the request is approved, the student forfeits the entire housing application and contract fee. If the request is denied, the student remains responsible for the cost of the room for the summer session.

The student agrees to abide by all University Housing policies as listed in the *Guidelines for University Living*, the *Student Code of Conduct*, or any other published Lawrence Tech document. Violations of any of the policies, or any other conduct deemed to be such as to require removal of a student from a residence hall in the best interests of the other residents, shall be grounds for termination of the contract by the University.

Receipt of the completed application and fee by the Office of University Housing does not guarantee a specific assignment to a residence hall. Final assignment will be determined by the Office of University Housing. The student must be officially admitted and enrolled for credit-bearing course work at Lawrence Tech and making satisfactory academic progress to live in the residence halls. The Office of University Housing reserves the right to reassign and consolidate residents at the University's discretion. Room space cannot be sublet nor can a contract be transferred, sold, or assigned to another person. The student may not conduct or solicit business in the residence hall,

including from within the student's room, without the prior approval from the director of residence life.

The student is responsible for damages beyond normal wear and tear to the room and furnishings. University Housing staff will conduct a damage assessment of each room at the end of the housing contract and charge all roommates as deemed appropriate not to do so.

Lawrence Technological University is not responsible for the personal property of the student or the loss, damage, or destruction of that property. All personal property of the student and any property in the student's custody belonging to a third party is the sole responsibility of the student.

The University will release student contact information to roommates unless the student notifies the Office of University Housing in writing at the time of application not to do so.

Notice of Non-Discriminatory Policy
