To complete the first two years of a 2 + 2 agreement with Lawrence Technological University (LTU) for a Bachelor of Science in Architecture or Interior Architecture, students intending to transfer must be enrolled with both LCC and LTU. Additionally, the following two LTU courses must be completed at the designated LTU site in Lansing during the second year of study: ARC 2117 – Integrated Design Studio 1 (7 LTU Credits) and ARC 2126 – Integrated Design Studio II (6 LTU Credits).
