Getting Started

Applicants must:

- Hold a bachelor's or master's degree (or equivalent) from an accredited college or university with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Provide official transcripts from every college or university attended.
- Submit application form with application fee.
- Submit professional resume.
- Have GPA of 3.0 or higher for their last 60 hours of undergraduate course work to be exempt from taking the GMAT. For applicants with a GPA of less than 3.0, a personal interview, significant work experience, a GMAT, or other assessment tool may be required.
