## Your 3 IDs and Passwords

### 1. BANNERWEB ID AND PIN

The BannerWeb ID is your 9-digit student number. For example: 000123456

The initial BannerWeb PIN is your date of birth in MMDDYY format. For example: 112487

You must change your PIN the first time you log in to Bannerweb to another 6-digit number.

### 2. LAPTOP, LTU NETWORK, AND E-MAIL USER ID AND PASSWORD

The user ID is your first and last name initials followed by your 9-digit student ID number. For example: ab000123456

The initial login password is your date of birth in MMDDYY format.

You must change your password the first time you log in. You must be on campus to change your password. You cannot log into your email until your initial password has been changed.

This password expires every 180 days.

### 3. BLACKBOARD ID AND PASSWORD

The Blackboard User ID is your first and last name initials followed by your 9-digit student ID number. For example: ab000123456

Initial password is your 9-digit student ID number. For example: 000123456

You should change your password the first time you log in to keep your information safe.

*If you forget any of your passwords and need them reset, bring your LTU Photo ID card to the Help Desk, and we will reset them.*

## FAQ

### • What does the LTU laptop program provide?

The LTU laptop program provides an LTU laptop or tablet, access to pre-loaded University software, Blackboard (the University's Course Management Software), the University network, the University Help Desk, BannerWeb System for students and insurance coverage for accidental damage.

### • What accessories can students purchase?

LTU does not sell accessories. Accessories may be purchased from CDW or the vendor of your choice. However, these accessories are the sole property of the purchaser and are not covered by LTU's insurance. They do not qualify for LTU Help Desk repair or exchange. ### • What am I responsible for when I have the laptop?

Students are responsible for picking up the laptop at the beginning of each academic year. Students are responsible for keeping the laptop clean and in good condition, keeping the laptop in their possession and in a secure place, and returning the laptop with all accessories to the Help Desk during the posted return dates.

### • What if a student does not return the laptop in a timely manner?

Students are required to return their laptops during the return period as specified in the laptop agreement. Return dates are always the week of final exams, and are posted on the LTU website and on Blackboard prior to the end of classes. The LTU agreement specifies that if students do not return their laptop within the designated return period a penalty of \$20 per business day will be added to their student accounts.

### • What if my laptop is lost or stolen?

You must file a police report in the jurisdiction in which the laptop is alleged to have been stolen or lost. The report must include the make, model and manufacturer's serial number on the laptop. [For full details see our website.](#)
