**\*Strategic Management is the capstone course for the MBA program and must be taken after the core classes are completed.**

- The MBA is a 36 credit hour program. For most students the MBA can be completed in 23 months as long as both courses are completed per module and without breaks.
- Classes at Schoolcraft are offered on Saturdays and are 13 weeks in duration. The morning classes are held from 8:30 – 11:30am; the afternoon classes are held from noon – 3:00pm. When possible certain courses are taught online or in a hybrid style (1/2 on-line, 1/2 on-ground).
- Pre-Core courses must be completed before corresponding core classes. Pre-Core courses may be completed at Schoolcraft College, LTU’s main campus or another College or University upon approval.
- Up to 12 hrs of credit from another accredited graduate program may be transferred.
- If a student deviates from this outline of courses it may be necessary to complete courses at another campus to avoid delays in the progression of the program.
- If a student enters the program after Module 1 it is the student’s responsibility to make up the missed modules before taking any courses that require a Pre-Requisite.
