**Insurance Information**

The plan has contracts with Blue Care Network, EyeMed Vision Care and Alliance Health & Life Ins Co to pay Health, PPO Contract, Vision, Prescription drug, hearing claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2008 were \$2,568,990.
