

SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS



Participants are not permitted to leave campus unless they are part of a supervised group.

Automobiles and motorcycles are not permitted for resident campers and are not encouraged for commuters. The University assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items.

Leave expensive jewelry and other items at home.

Housing

Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or controlled substances, fireworks, explosives, weapons, and smoking are strictly prohibited in the Residence Hall and camps. The burning of candles is also prohibited.

Anyone involved in harassing or annoying other campers by playing abusive or shameful tricks or intentionally humiliating them with practical jokes will be sent home immediately. The Lawrence Technological University Summer Camp Program has a zero tolerance for hazing!

It is illegal to tamper with fire alarms, fire fighting equipment, and elevators.

You must leave your room as you found it. Fastening anything to the walls or tampering with window screens is not permitted and can result in damage charges assessed against you.

Excessive noise or rowdiness cannot be tolerated.

Radios and lights are to be turned off at lights-out time.

Friends not enrolled in a Lawrence Technological University Summer Camp are not allowed to visit participants during the camp. Members of the opposite sex are not permitted in participants' rooms. Note: if the need arises, a child can be checked out of camp by a parent/guardian, but arrangements for check-out and check-in must be coordinated with camp staff.

Violations of the above rules may result in dismissal, without refund, from camp. Replacement costs will be assessed to anyone who removes or damages University property.
