**PROGRAM STRUCTURE**

- 2 year modular cohort program, 36 credits
- Each 6-week course includes an on-line learning component and 2 or 3 weekend on-ground sessions.
- Pre-Core/Foundational coursework in statistics, economics, accounting, and business law are required unless applicant has undergraduate coursework in these specific academic areas or relevant professional experience.
- Pre-Core/Foundational coursework can be fulfilled through Weekend Precore Seminars (except statistics).
- Up to 12 hours of credit from another accredited graduate program may be transferred.
