

Username and Passwords

Usernames

For students, beginning Fall 2010, the same username will log you into Blackboard, Email, and campus computers, laptops, and tablets.

To find your username:

1. Log into BannerWeb
2. Click on Personal Information
3. Click on View Email Addresses
4. The Campus email address before @ltu.edu is your new username

You must change your PIN to another 6-digit number the first time you log in to BannerWeb.

BannerWeb

The BannerWeb ID is your 9-digit student number. For example: 000123456. The initial BannerWeb password (PIN) is your date of birth in the MMDDYY format. You must change your PIN to another 6-digit number the first time you log in to BannerWeb.

Passwords

The initial password for BannerWeb, Blackboard, Email, and Campus Computers is your date of birth in the MMDDYY format. At this time, the passwords are maintained separately.

Campus Computer and Network passwords expire every 90 days and must be changed from a computer on campus, or from the myPassword website, mypassword.campus.ltu.edu.

Email, Blackboard, and BannerWeb passwords do not currently expire.

For Off-Campus Software Access

1. Open web browser
2. Type "https://tunnel.ltu.edu" and hit "Enter"
3. Enter your LTU Network Username and Password
4. Press the "Login" button
5. If you have disabled Popups, click on the yellow bar and select the option to install the Cisco SSL VPN Client.
6. When the Security Warning box pops up, click on the "Install" button to complete the installation.
7. The SSL VPN connection is established when a "Golden Key" appears in the System Tray on the lower right corner of your desktop.
