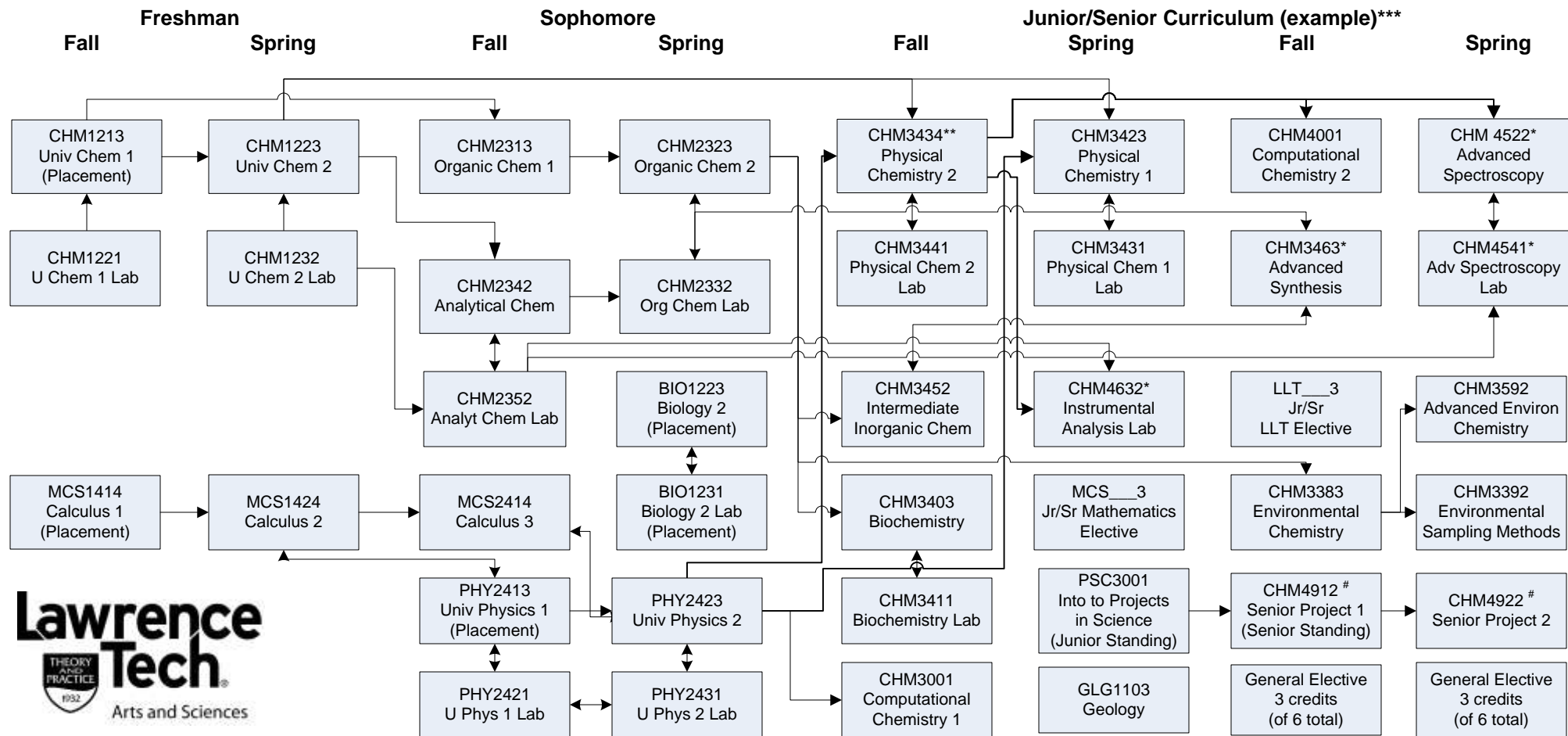


Bachelor of Science in Environmental Chemistry (123 credits)
