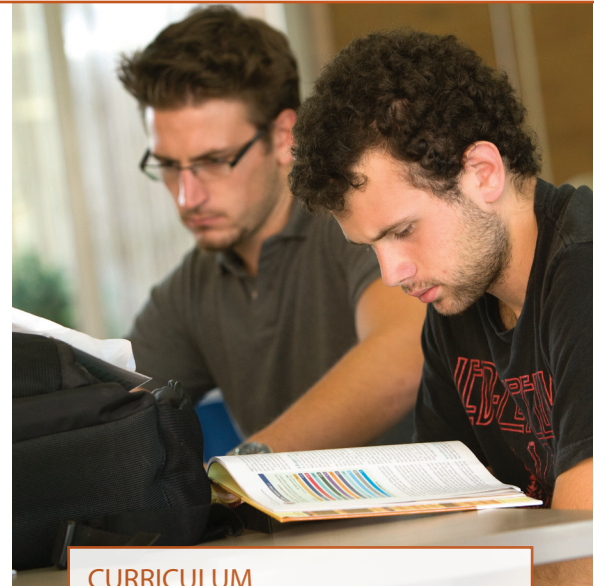

Lawrence Technological University's minor in Spanish focuses on providing you a strong foundation in both conversational and business Spanish.
