- If a course requires 2 or more courses, in order to transfer to LTU, the student must take all courses listed as the equivalent for the course to transfer. Taking one course of that equivalent will not be given elective credit.
- A maximum of 60 semester hours of community college coursework may transfer.
- All classes on the guide must have a grade of “C”, or higher in order to transfer.
- We welcome and encourage you to contact an LTU Admissions Counselor early in your community college career to ensure maximum transfer of credit.

- Transferring Architecture students are advised to submit a portfolio documenting their community college art and architecture coursework for placement purposes.
