Application Instructions

- Please print legibly or type. Return the application with a \$250 housing and meal plan application and contract fee to the Office of University Housing if not paid previously. Make checks payable to: Lawrence Technological University. This fee will become your deposit.
- It is important that the student completes the application, not the parent or guardian.
- Lawrence Tech reserves the right to assign or deny housing at its sole discretion.
- Please visit www.ltu.edu/housing for current housing and meal plan rates and meal plan requirements.

1. Roommate Preferences

- If you know of a student with whom you would like to share a room, write their name in the allotted space. The request must be mutual; the student must want to live with you as well.
- University Housing will not honor any roommate request that may discriminate against another student.

2. Room Preferences

- Please rank, from 1 – 6, your room preference in desired order.
 - 1 means most desired
 - 6 means least desired
- Every effort is made to accommodate your preferences. If your preferences cannot be met, you will be placed according to availability.
- Only junior, senior, and graduate students are approved to live at Arbor Lofts.

3. Meal Plans

- Meals are provided at the Blue Devil Cafe, an all-inclusive restaurant where you pay once upon entry.
- Blue Devil Dollars is a declining balance account placed on your student ID and can be used at all Lawrence Tech dining locations, including the Blue Devil Cafe, Einstein Bros. Bagels, P.O.D. Express, or Jets off campus.
- All residential students are required to purchase a meal plan.

4. Disability Accommodations

5. Summer Housing

If you need summer housing, a separate contract, the *Housing Application and Contract for Summer Session*, is required. You can find it at www.ltu.edu/housing.

Contract Terms and Conditions

Highlights

1. A \$250 housing and meal plan application and contract fee is required if not previously paid.
2. Cancellation dates and fees are in effect regardless of when you apply.
3. Application is for the entire academic year or from the time of arrival until the end of the spring semester.
4. There is no trial period or temporary housing available.
5. The contract is not a lease and cannot be terminated at will.
6. You may request to cancel the contract; however, the request is not a guarantee. If the request is approved, you will be billed a forfeiture fee.
7. When you sign the application and contract, you acknowledge that:
 - You have read and understood the entire application and contract and the *University Housing Guidelines*.
 - You agree to the entire application and contract.
 - Do not provide your electronic signature if you do not understand or agree with any of the statements on the application and contract.
